

## NATIONAL COMBINED REGATTA - INFORMATION FOR CADETS

The Dress of the Day for all Cadets is as ordered by the Staff Recreation Officer (SRO)

## I. COMPETITORS DRESS

- a. Competitors in the Rowing event are to wear shorts with coloured singlet.
- b. Competitors in the Paddlesport event are to wear matching team short/track suits in their Area colours suitable to the weather conditions (cags should be worn when necessary).
- Competitors in the Boat Handling Competitions (Rowing, Sailing and Power) are to wear Area Tracksuits or as appropriate to the conditions of the day

#### 2. EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

All Cadets are required to provide:

- a. Uniform as required, Adults & Duty Cadets Only
- Approved MOD Buoyancy Aid / Lifejacket etc (Rowing, Paddlesport, Boat Handling (Rowing, Sailing and Power) competitors and Officials whose duties require Boat work or jetty working).
- c. Overnight sleeping gear, Toilet gear and towels
- d. Camp bed or bed roll, sleeping bag and pillow (no bed or bedding will be available) Ear Plugs!!!
- e. Completed SCC T1 Card (Cadet Only)
- f. Completed SCC T1(MED) (if on any form of medication)

#### 3. VICTUALLING AND MESSING

Cadets will be accommodated within the EXCEL Centre.

A Cadet Canteen will be available on Friday evening and throughout the day on Saturday, for the sale of nutty and soft drinks.
